The new boutique wholesale fashion venue showcases the best in women's contemporary bridge and sportswear, accessories, and better men's, within a modern, high-design environment in the heart of Downtown. The Fashion Industry Gallery has struck a chord within the industry, bringing greater attention to Dallas from the fashion world. So many buyers have flocked to its 42 galleries, carrying over 100 new fashion lines not previously sold in Dallas, that the Fashion Industry Gallery will expand another 10,000 square feet onto a second level by October 2005.
